

## Worship Band Team Coordinator (*January 1, 2018*)

This position provides team leadership assistance to the Band Ministry Team, and to the Worship Arts Board and the Worship Arts Ministry of Covenant Church. This position furthers the mission and vision of Covenant by:

- 1) Collaborating closely on a weekly basis with the Worship Arts Pastor to assist in planning and executing various elements of the worship service, specifically in the area of the worship bands
- 2) Collaborating with the Worship Arts Pastor and Worship Arts Ministry Board on ministry activities, seasonal and thematic special music, and service worship elements
- 3) Planning, coordinating, and directing the worship band rehearsals on a weekly basis
- 4) In collaboration with the Worship Pastor, Identifying other's with the gift of leadership, recruiting and giving them opportunities to lead in rehearsals and develop their gifts
- 5) Meeting as needed with the Senior Pastor, Worship Arts Lead Person, Worship Elder, Ministry Assistant, and with the Worship Arts Board Members to evaluate worship services, develop goals, review efforts, and make plans for the worship area
- 6) Modeling servant leadership

### Key areas of accountability:

- Centrality to the Holy Bible and its truths in musical selections and approaches
- Relating with the Worship Arts Pastor, Worship Arts Leadership Team and Worship Arts Ministry in a loving, God-honoring manner while encouraging giving our best for God's glory
- Assisting as needed in music selection that is thematically and musically appropriate, and stylistically sensitive
- Preparing and studying song charts in order to lead an effective rehearsal with all ensemble members
- Committed to growing in leadership and musical skills, as part of our commitment to ongoing discipleship
- Attending weekly Worship Arts Ministry-related meetings
- Assisting with the coordination of special music and seasonal concerts and presentations with the Worship Arts Board

### Spiritual gifts, qualities, experience, education and skills required:

- Servant leadership
- Encouragement
- Interpersonal skills
- Band leadership skills
- Desire to grow others in and through worship
- Desire to grow personally as a leader
- Fostering a heart that knows and loves Christ Jesus and desires to grow personally and corporately in Him and His love

### Minimum hours required:

- Worship Planning – up to 1 hours weekly
  - Thursday Rehearsals & Worship Arts Meeting – 2 – 2.5 hours weekly
    - Or, working with an identified lay leader in the role of mentoring and fostering “giving ministry away”
  - Sunday morning– 4 hours weekly (if scheduled)
  - Practice and music preparation – up to 1 hours weekly
- Total Time Commitment = 6-8 hours weekly + possible extra rehearsals and preparation time required on a seasonal basis*
