Three Important Steps to Family Discipleship in a Season of Social Distancing

1. Help your children engage with our online worship service:

- Everyone sing out loud together. Consider standing while singing occasionally.
- Encourage children (3rd grade and older) to have their Bible with them and find any passage that is mentioned.
- Provide children with paper and a pencil. Ask them to draw a picture of something mentioned in the sermon and write down a phrase that captured their attention.

2. Be the Sunday School Teacher

After participating in our online worship service take 5-10 minutes to walk through this simple Gospel Project Sunday School material. What we love about the Gospel Project is it teaches our children the stories of the Bible while consistently showing how so much of the Bible's message is pointing to Jesus.
