

## Ministry Role

Partner with Covenant Next Generation Ministries to help students Know Jesus, Grow with His People and Go to the World. While working in collaboration with staff members giving leadership to Children's Ministry and Senior High Ministry, this role will focus on students grades six through eight. This role also provides a hands-on learning experience for young leaders seeking to further develop skills for and/or discern a call to vocational ministry.
