Ministry Role

This role is an 8-10 hour/week position which runs from August 2021 - May 2022. The role exists to give leadership to the Middle School Ministry (in collaboration with the current volunteer team and high school ministry leaders). With and through this leader team, this intern will provide an environment in which students grade six through eight can Know Jesus, Grow with His People and Go to the World. This intern will “plant and water” to encourage middle school students to grow as followers of Christ.

Overview

Covenant Church, a member of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church, is a Christ-centered and biblically-based community.
