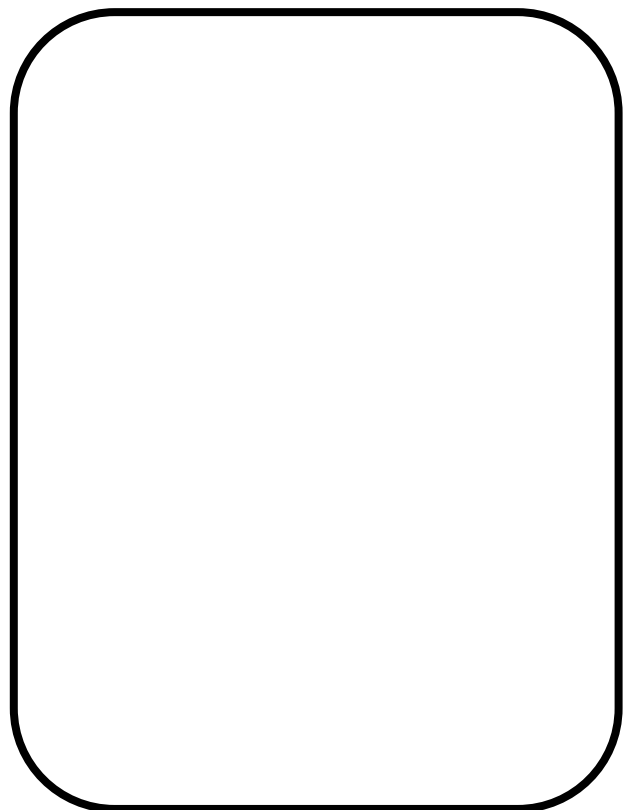
**If you get a BINGO, keep going and try to get ALL the words for a GRAND PRIZE. Bingo Prize cart is in the Family Lobby.**

- Name some things that could help you follow what the Bible says?

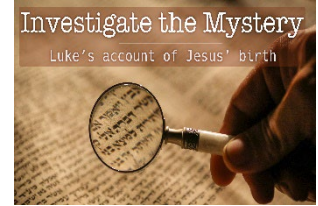

**GOD CONTROLS EVERYTHING JOB**

**KEY PASSAGE:** Psalm 135:5-6

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:** Who is in control of everything? *God is in control of everything in heaven and on earth. Nothing is outside of God's good plan.*

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** Job learned that God is all-powerful, sovereign, and good. When we face suffering, we can hope in God. God sent Jesus, the only truly innocent One, to suffer and die so that everyone who trusts in Him can have forgiveness and eternal life.
