

Gospel Project Lesson GOD STOPPED THE JORDAN RIVER JOSHUA 3-4

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 119:105

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What is the Bible? The Bible is God's Word that tells us what is true about God and ourselves.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

God went ahead of Joshua and the Israelites into the land He had promised. He showed His power to them so they would trust in Him. When Jesus came to earth, He showed His power so people would trust in Him and be saved from sin.
