HOW THIS WORKS

Checking Out and Returning

Checking out a book requires the **Librarika app**, which can be downloaded from either Apple or Google Play. Once downloaded, follow the instructions below to set up a free account, peruse the entire library, and check out the books you'd like. You can also visit the library online: <https://librarika.com>

Creating a Librarika Account

The first step is to download the Librarika app from either [Apple](#) or [Google Play](#), or visit the [Librarika website](#). You can then become a member of the Covenant Discipleship Resource Library either by submitting a membership request yourself or by accepting an email invitation from the library staff.

Option 1: Request Member Access Manually

1. Go to the Librarika Sign Up page to create and verify your free account (<https://librarika.com/users/register>).
2. Log in at Librarika.
3. Go to the My Libraries menu.
4. Click Request Member Access.
5. Enter "<https://discipleshipresources.librarika.com>" and click Submit.
6. This should automatically create your new account.

Option 2: Join via Email Invitation

- Request an invitation from Peg Baugh or Rob Eyman (see below). They will email the invitation to you.
- Open the invitation email.
- Click the activation link inside the email.
- Log in to your existing account or sign up if you are new.
- Choose a password.
- Click "I agree, please create my account" to complete your membership.
- Confirm email then click, "Yes, please join me in."

Assessing a Title

As a resource library, we expect people to borrow books only long enough to evaluate if they are something they want to use. While we encourage you to make your assessment while you are at Covenant, you are welcome to take books home with you.

If you choose to take a volume home, please return it within one week. Use the Librarika App to register the return, then leave it on the Drop Off Shelf in the center bookcase or return it yourself to the proper bookcase, shelf and location (alphabetical order by author's last name).

May God's Spirit use this resource to guide you, your family, and your small group to the next step He is leading you to take in your growth in Christ.

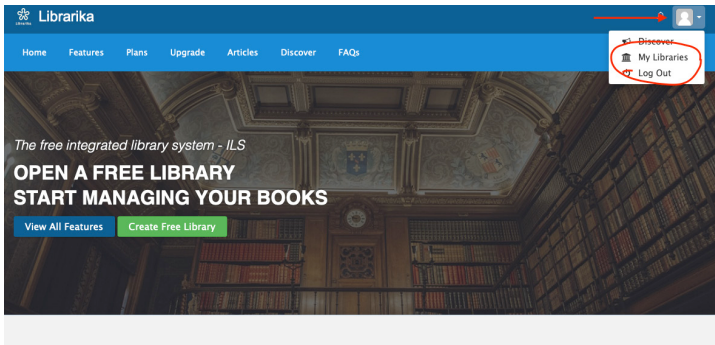

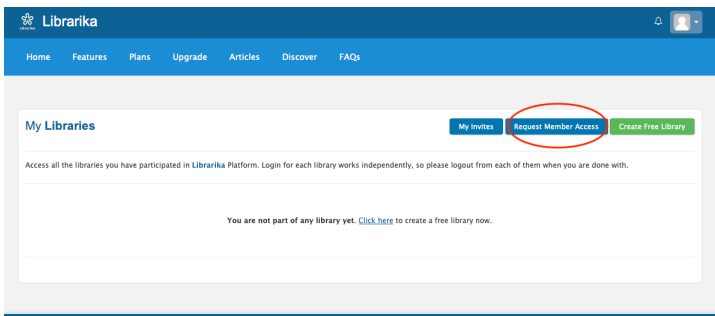

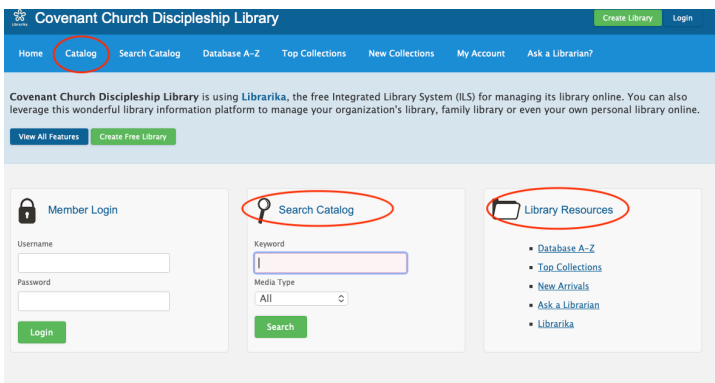
